Badge Requirements

- ✓ Been in existence at least one year with a focus on relationships for young people
- Every three years complete the badging assessment and verification process
- ✓ Annually create and make progress on Improvement and Innovation Plan

QMS Silver Partner

Badge Requirements

- ✓ Been in existence at least three years with a focus on relationships for young people
- Every three years complete the badging assessment and verification process
- Annually creates and makes progress on an Improvement and Innovation Plan
- ✓ Program has 85% of alignment with a minimum 3 out of 5 rating on all required quality measures

- ✓ Program has 100% of quality measures fully in practice (minimum of 3 out of 5 rating)
